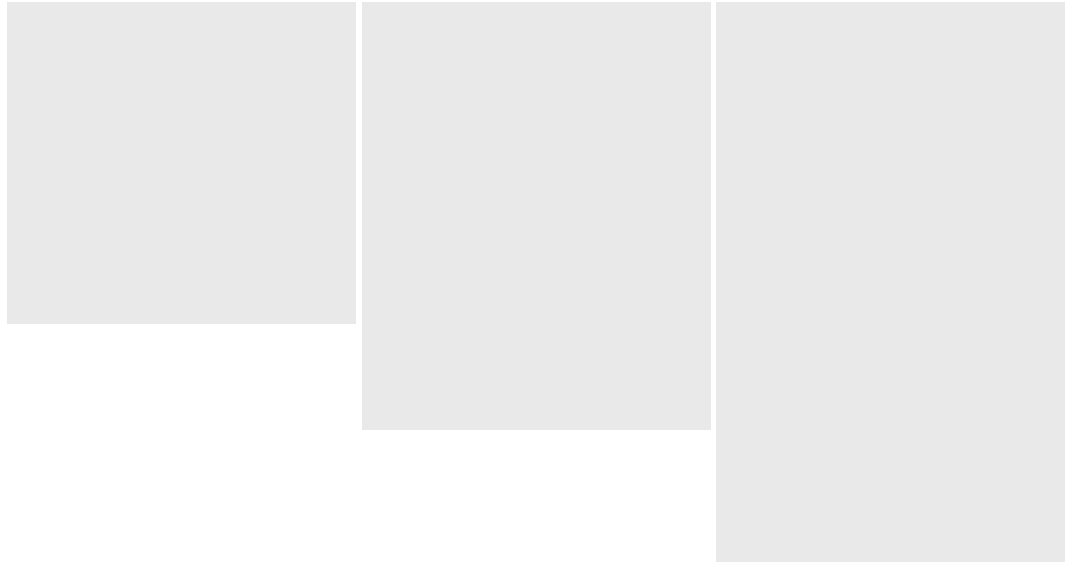

**SUBSIDISED | \$684**

The Queensland Government will offset the cost of study for **eligible students**. You will still need to pay for a portion of your study costs. The amount above is what you will need to pay.

**CONCESSION | \$102**

You are eligible for the concession price of a course if you are eligible for subsidised training, and are listed on an Australian Government Low Income Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card, if you are Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander, you hold a Department of Veterans' Affairs Pensioner Concession Card, or if you have a disability.



### Outcome

- Successful completion of the Certificate III in Individual Support Ageing/Home and Community Care is the entry level requirement for employment in the aged care industry.
- Students can gain employment as an Assistant in Nursing Aged Care or personal care worker.
- Successful students of this program will have the acquired skills and knowledge to enable them to work in a variety of institutions such as nursing homes, hostels, retirement villages, hospitals, community centres and in private homes with a registered agency. With the additional four units from the Disability qualification students may be eligible to work as a disability support worker.
- On successful completion of this course, students may consider further study at a higher tertiary level within the vocational education and training sector.
