The

1. **Working with Children Check Queensland students** - The Working with Children Check (Blue Card Application) must be completed person for Queensland students live **less than 50 km** from TAFE Queensland Gold Coast, Southport Campus. Information can be viewed at [www.wcc.qld.gov.au](#). All original identification documents need to be sighted and students are requested to bring documents with them for submission of their application. If a student resides **more than 50 km** from Queensland Gold Coast, the 'Confirmation of identity' form must be submitted with the Blue Card application. Students may submit by email or in person.
Interstate students - must refer to their state websites for further information on how to apply for Working with Children Check.

2. **Vaccination**

Hepatitis B vaccination, commencement of vaccination blood test results showing immunity.

3. **Australian Federal Police (AFP)**

Potential students are advised to contact the Vocational Placement Coordinator should they have a notification or criminal history that may impact on their acceptance facilities for placement assessment and therefore affect course outcomes. Students must be able to provide an original Australian Federal Police check on request of a form at any time. Please refer to the Australian Federal Police website to download the application form. Approximate cost \$45.00 (N.B: certificate MUST be issued by the Australian Federal Police. All other types of police checks will not be accepted.) Your current AFP documentation must be no older than 3 months prior to the start of placement.

\$ SUBSIDISED | \$754

The Queensland Government will offset the cost of study for **eligible students**. You will still need to pay for a portion of your study costs. The amount above is what you will need to pay.

\$ CONCESSION | \$172

You are eligible for the concession price of a course if you are eligible for subsidised training, and are listed on an Australian Government Low Income Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card, if you are Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander, you hold a Department of Veterans' Affairs Pensioner Concession Card, or if you have a disability.

Outcome

- Successful completion of the Certificate III in Individual Support Ageing/Home and Community Care is the entry level requirement for employment in the aged care industry.
- Students can gain employment as an Assistant in Nursing Aged Care or personal care worker.
- Successful students of this program will have the acquired skills and knowledge to enable them to work in a variety of institutions such as nursing homes, hostels, retirement villages, hospitals, community centres and in private homes with a registered agency. With the additional Disability qualification students may be eligible to work as a disability support worker.
- On successful completion of this course, students may consider further study at a higher tertiary level within the vocational education and training sector.
